

USC Football Alumnus Larry Markowitz, father of USC Football Alumnus Abe Markowitz has passed away

Laurence Jay Markowitz, USC Football 1950-1953 passed away of natural causes on Saturday evening May 7, 2022 at 9pm.

His son Barry Markowitz, daughter Linda Markowitz Gilbert and grandson Abe Markowitz were at his bedside at the moment of his passing.

Larry played on the 1950 USC Freshman Football Team, then served in the Korean War, active duty, in the US Army Air Corps. Larry returned to USC's Football Team in 1952 (ineligible due to the absence of 1 credit) then played Halfback and Defensive Back on the 1953 USC Varsity. In the Spring of 1954 Larry suffered a career ending knee injury

Larry continued to serve USC supporting the USC Football Program financially and in recruiting when alumni were allowed to do so.

Larry and his wife Patricia Love Markowitz will be buried tomorrow, Thursday in Southern California.
